MICHELLE BULAU MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The Michelle Bulau Memorial Scholarship was established to provide an annual scholarship to assist with educational costs, including tuition, fees, books, supplies, tools, and room and board for college students who meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must be a high school senior or graduate of St. Mary's High School in O'Neill, Nebraska.
- Must be pursuing post-secondary education in the medical field at an accredited community
 college, college or university. Also open to graduate studies. Eligible fields are a degree in
 medicine, nursing, anesthesia, physical therapy, physician assistant, speech therapy, respiratory
 therapy, medical technician, laboratory technician, radiology technician, dentistry, chiropractic
 and optometry.
- 3. Must have a "C" or 2.0 accumulative grade point average.
- 4. Must explain a financial need.
- 5. Must have a good moral character.

All scholarship money distributed from the Michelle Bulau Memorial Scholarship will be forwarded to, and will be disbursed by, the financial aid department of the school the recipient attends or paid directly to any vendor for required tools, equipment, supplies, etc., the recipient needs in education classes. Past scholarship recipients may reapply for the scholarship.

At the beginning of the first term, funds for one-half (1/2) of the scholarship will be issued to the educational institution which the student is attending. After completion of first term, with proof of GPA of C or 2.75 and enrollment in second term, funds will be issued for remainder of scholarship. Student may lose scholarship and remaining funds if he/she fails to complete first term or attain GPA.
